

Additional Notes

- 1 Pin 1 (red) and Pin 4 (yellow) are crossed. D.I.N. is a european 'norm' originating from Germany. The D.I.N. abbreviation stands for 'Deutshe Industrie Norm' and means translated 'German Industry Standard'.
- 2 Each of the 5 wires have an individual (stranded) shield.
- 3 Pin 2 (ground) can be any color, but is usually brown or black.
